# Novel Coronavirus (COVID -19)

## Daily Update

Date/Time of Issue: March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2020 @230PM

**Executive Summary:** The Butler County General Health District (BCGHD) is working with the City of Hamilton Health Department (CHHD), the City of Middletown Health Department (CMHD), and the Butler County Emergency Management Agency (BCEMA) in response to the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic.

### MAJOR UPDATES AND ACTIONS

- BCGHD is continuing contact tracing and resource/food support for all newly confirmed cases of COVID19 reported to BCGHD.
- BCGHD has appointed a staff member as the lead for discussions and plans for vulnerable populations in Butler County. They will be working closely with identified partners already working on supporting vulnerable populations and identifying possible quarantine locations for people experiencing homelessness.
- BCGHD is participating in regional Hospital calls daily and in twice weekly calls with the Ohio Department of Health and other Local Health Departments.
- BCGHD is sharing PPE conservation resource guides from the Health Collaborative.
