Due to the high volume of cases we are no longer able to send letters to contacts or those who are currently in quarantine.

## IF YOU ARE POSITIVE OR HAVE BEEN EXPOSED, IT IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT THAT YOU FOLLOW THIS GUIDANCE:



**If you are aware that you have tested positive, please stay home for at least 10 days. If you have symptoms, isolate yourself from other healthy individuals in your home for at least 10 days and until you meet all 4 of these requirements:**

1. At least 10 days since symptoms first appeared
2. At least 24 hours since last fever without the use of fever-reducing meds
3. Symptoms have improved
4. If tested positive for COVID-19, but show no symptoms, you can be with others after 10 days have passed since test.

**If you are aware you have been in contact with a case, please stay home for 14 days. If you live with a case, please stay home for 14 days after the case has recovered.**

### IN ADDITION:

**Contact your healthcare provider and seek care if needed.**



A close contact is defined as less than 6 feet apart for 15 minutes or longer over 24 hours, whether or not masks are worn.



Inform those on your contact list that you have tested positive for COVID-19 and that they should stay home.
