The Perinatal Hepatitis B Prevention program was created to prevent babies of Hepatitis B-positive mothers from contracting Hepatitis B virus at birth. The local health department follows all babies born to Hepatitis B positive moms to help ensure they get their vaccinations and grow up healthy.
