**HIV testing recommendation for tuberculosis**

The CDC recommends that anyone with Tuberculosis (TB) (suspected, inactive/latent or active), should be tested for HIV/AIDS infection. HIV infection weakens the immune system. HIV infection can allow inactive TB (Latent) to become active and you can spread the tuberculosis to others.

Many people with HIV do not have symptoms and do not know they have it, so it is important to be tested to be sure.

Caracole's prevention program provides FREE HIV testing. Walk in appointments are available Monday-Friday 9am – 5pm and Thursdays from 9am – 8pm at 4138 Hamilton Ave., Cincinnati, Ohio 45223, 513-761-1480.
