Please Read This Important Information About Vaccines for Children!

The State of Ohio has new guidelines for paying for children's vaccines.

WHAT THIS NEW GUIDELINE MEANS TO YOU:

Insurance Type (or no insurance)	How this will affect your family
If your child has <u>MEDICAID OR A MEDICAID MANAGED CARE PLAN</u> (Caresource, Buckeye, United Health Care, Molina, or Paramount)	Your child can continue to receive vaccines at NO CHARGE if you bring in a current insurance card.
If your child has <u>NO INSURANCE</u> , or your <u>insurance does not pay for shots</u>	You will be asked to pay \$10 per shot, with a maximum of \$40 per child, per day. Cash only, no checks, no charges. No one will be turned away due to inability to pay.
If your child has <u>AETNA, ANTHEM, OR UNITED HEALTH CARE</u> (commercial/private)	Your child can continue to receive vaccines at NO CHARGE if you bring in a current insurance card. *Please call to check on vaccine availability*
If your child has <u>ANY OTHER COMMERCIAL/PRIVATE MEDICAL INSURANCE</u>	<u>We are no longer able to offer you the state cost for vaccines.</u> You will be charged a fee based on our cost to purchase vaccines from private vendors. Please check our current price list. Costs vary from shot to shot. Cash only, no checks, no charges. *Please call to check on vaccine availability*
